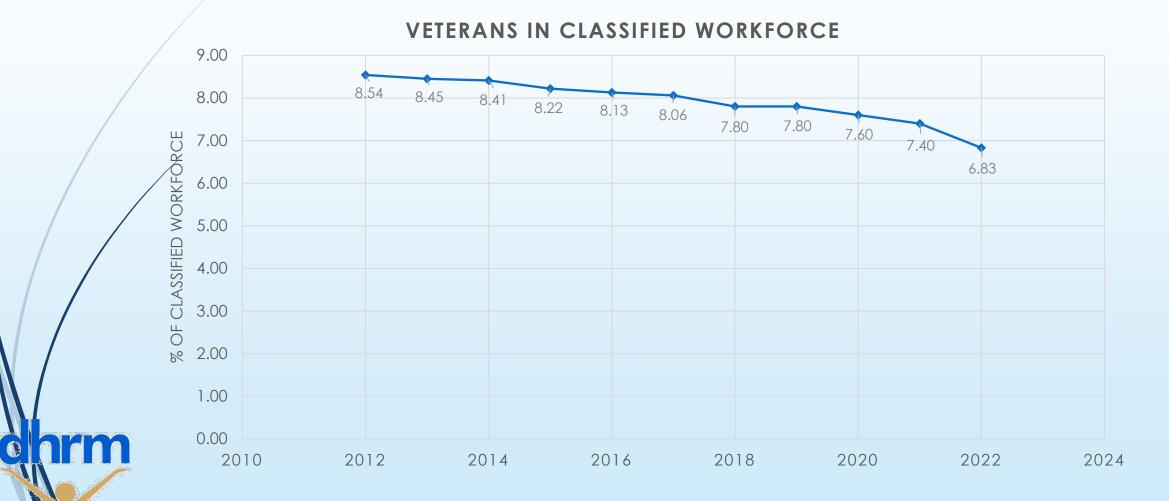

Compensation

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- Current classified salary structure compression in pay bands 1-4 due to minimum wage increase for calendar year 2023.
 - adjustment made to pay bands 1 and 2 effective 1/1/2023
- Targeted salary increases provided to specific positions in FY22 to help address pay compression
