Appropriation Act Authority

(Ch. 2, 2024 Special Session I)

- Item 1, paragraph K establishes the Joint Subcommittee for Health and Human Resources Oversight
 - Five members to be appointed by each Chair of the House Appropriations (HAC) and Senate Finance and Appropriations Committees (SFAC)
 - Chair and Vice Chair to be elected annually
 - Broad authority to monitor, evaluate and recommend actions to the General Assembly
 - May seek technical support from staff of HAC, SFAC, JLARC and the Joint Commission on Health Care



Specific Purposes

- Monitor, evaluate and respond to federal legislation that repeals, amends or replaces the Affordable Care Act, Medicaid, the Children's Health Insurance Program or any proposals to block grant or change the method by which these programs are funded
 - Evaluate federal changes for opportunities to improve Virginia's Medicaid and other health insurance programs
- Provide ongoing oversight of initiatives and operations of the Health and Human Resources (HHR) agencies
 - Medicaid/CHIP; managed care; waiver programs; enterprise system; eligibility, enrollment and renewal processes; and organizational structure and realignment
 - Children's Services Act improvements
 - Other initiatives and programmatic changes across HHR agencies
