<u>HB 73</u>	Hope	Unlawful detainer; expungement of action, entering of an order without further petition or hearing.
<u>HB 102</u>	Reaser	Court-appointed counsel; raises the limitation of fees.
<u>HB 172</u>	Hope	Family or household member; clarifies definition, penalty.
HB 173	Simon	Plastic firearms and unfinished frames, etc.; manufacture, import, etc. prohibited, penalties.
<u>HB 175</u>	Simon	Assault firearms; carrying in public areas prohibited, penalty.
<u>HB 183</u>	Simon	Firearms; storage in residence where minor or person prohibited from possessing is present, penalty.
<u>HB 250</u>	Glass	Law-enforcement officers; interrogation practices.
<u>HB 362</u>	McClure	Firearms; purchase, etc., following an assault and battery against an intimate or dating partner.
<u>HB 454</u>	Callsen	Firearm/explosive material; carrying w/in Capitol Square or bldg. owned or leased by Commonwealth.
<u>HB 457</u>	Callsen	Decreasing probation period; establishes criteria for mandatory reduction.

<u>HB 555</u>	Hope	Corrections Ombudsman, Office of the Department of; created, report.
<u>HB 611</u>	Price	Civilian deaths in custody; report.
HB 633	Cherry	Labor trafficking; forced labor or service, penalties.
HB 637	Sullivan	Substantial Risk Order Training Program; Department of Criminal Justice Services to establish.
<u>HB 640</u>	Sullivan	Wrongful incarceration; compensation.
<u>HB 641</u>	Sullivan	Relief; Kingrea, David Wayne, compensation for wrongful inclusion on sex offender registry.

<u>HB 803</u>	Rasoul	Juveniles; expungement of court records.
<u>HB 838</u>	Hope	Police and court records; expungement, definition of 'otherwise dismissed.'
<u>HB 861</u>	Hernandez	Weapons; carrying into hospital that provides mental health services.
<u>HB 893</u>	McClure	Attorneys appointed to represent parents or guardians; qualifications and performance.
<u>HB 916</u>	Srinivasan	Substantial Risk Order Reporting System; established.
<u>HB 1174</u>	Sickles	Assault firearms; age requirement for purchase, penalty.
HB 1187	Hodges	Xylazine; penalty for manufacturing, selling, etc., for human consumption.
<u>HB 1195</u>	Hayes	Firearms; waiting period for purchases, penalty.
HB 1244	Cole	Restorative housing and isolated confinement; restrictions on use.
<u>HB 1246</u>	Willett	Law-enforcement training; communication with individuals with autism spectrum disorder.
<u>HB 1268</u>	Delaney	Community corrections alternative program; evaluation and diagnosis to determine eligibility.
<u>HB 1405</u>	Cousins	Prisoners; Department of Corrections- and jailer-issued identification.
