SB 451	Marsden	Income tax, corporate; distribution of revenues to state parks.
SB 483	Aird	Tangible personal property tax; exemption for indoor agriculture equipment and machinery.
SB 540	Bagby	Illegal gambling; exemptions.
SB 541	Bagby	Casino gaming; removes the City of Richmond as an eligible host city.
