HB716	Carnegie	Income tax, state; innocent spouse tax relief.
HB854	Cousins	Real property tax; local classification or designation for property, nonprofit organizations.
HB1233	Delaney	Va. Sexual & Domestic Violence Victim fund; fee for offenses related to solicitation of minors, etc.
HB943	Franklin, L.V.	Campus police officers; free use of toll facilities.
HB417	Guzman	Children of active duty service members or veterans; in-state tuition eligibility.
HB796	Hayes	Regulatory boards; adjustment of fees, recovery of disciplinary and monitoring costs, report.

<u>HB141</u>	Reid	Virginia Passenger Rail Authority; certain exemptions.
<u>HB404</u>	Reid	Enslaved Ancestors College Access Scholarship and Memorial Program; scholarships, administration.
<u>HB161</u>	Simon	Virginia Lottery; internet gaming authorized, definitions, effective clause.
<u>HB897</u>	Sullivan	Retail Sales and Use Tax; exemption for data centers, delayed effective date.
<u>HB1008</u>	Tran	Motor vehicle sales and use tax; exemption for electric vehicles, etc.
<u>HB1016</u>	Tran	Cats and dogs; Virginia Cooperative Extension Service to create a list of toxic houseplants.
