<u>SB 356</u>	Perry	Court-appointed counsel; raises limitation of fees that counsel can receive for representation.

<u>SB 383</u>	Deeds	Firearm/explosive material; carrying w/in Capitol Square or bldg. owned or leased by Commonwealth.

<u>SB 419</u>	Head	Family caregiver tax credit.
<u>SB 427</u>	Deeds	Petition for modification of a sentence; eligibility, procedures.
<u>SB 428</u>	VanValkenburg	Elections; allows for any local or constitutional office to be conducted by ranked choice voting.
<u>SB 431</u>	Suetterlein	School boards; expands availability of allowable alternatives for pupil transportation.
<u>SB 457</u>	Marsden	Driving Decarbonization Program and Fund; established and created.
<u>SB 459</u>	Marsden	Income tax; rolling conformity.
