<u>HB 1</u>	Ward	Minimum wage; increases wage to \$13.50 per hour effective January 1, 2025.
<u>HB 225</u>	Sickles	Dentist and Dental Hygienist Compact; authorizes Virginia to become a signatory to the Compact.
<u>HB 237</u>	Austin	Virginia Growth and Opportunity Board; increases membership.
<u>HB 356</u>	Fowler	Investment of public funds; qualified public entity allowed to invest in asset-backed securities.
<u>HB 462</u>	Runion	Virginia Public School Construction Grants Program and Fund; revision of guidelines, etc.
<u>HB 468</u>	McNamara	Financial Services Expansion Grant Fund; established.
<u>HB 510</u>	Cohen	Surplus line broker; any person required to be licensed as one shall not be subject to certain tax.
<u>HB 525</u>	Krizek	Casino gaming; limits on required local referendums.
HB 619	Price	Military centered community zones; localities may establish, by ordinance, one or more zones.
<u>HB 712</u>	Torian	Six-year financial plan; modifies requirements for plans submitted by Governor to General Assembly.
<u>HB 715</u>	Torian	Capital outlay plan; repeals existing six-year capital outlay for projects to be funded.
<u>HB 805</u>	Rasoul	Sales and use tax, local; additional tax authorized in counties & cities to support schools.
HB 819	Mundon King	Health insurance; coverage for prescription contraceptive drugs and devices.

<u>HB 840</u>	Austin	License plates, special; issuance of plates marking 250th anniversary of the American Revolution.
<u>HB 935</u>	LeVere Bolling	Health insurance; coverage for doula care services.
<u>HB 944</u>	Lopez	Forest Sustainability Fund; fund allocation.
HB 991	Maldonado	Gambling data; use of Cloud Technology.
<u>HB 1015</u>	Wilt	Agricultural best management practices & agricultural equipment purchase tax credits; sunset date.
<u>HB 1085</u>	Rasoul	PFAS Expert Advisory Committee; established, monitoring sources.
<u>HB 1130</u>	Hayes	Unconscious bias and cultural competency; Bd. of Medicine shall require continuing education, etc.
<u>HB 1502</u>	Willett	Tangible personal property tax; classification of certain vehicles, removes sunset date.
<u>HB 1508</u>	Wilt	Assessment of omitted taxes; erroneous payments.
