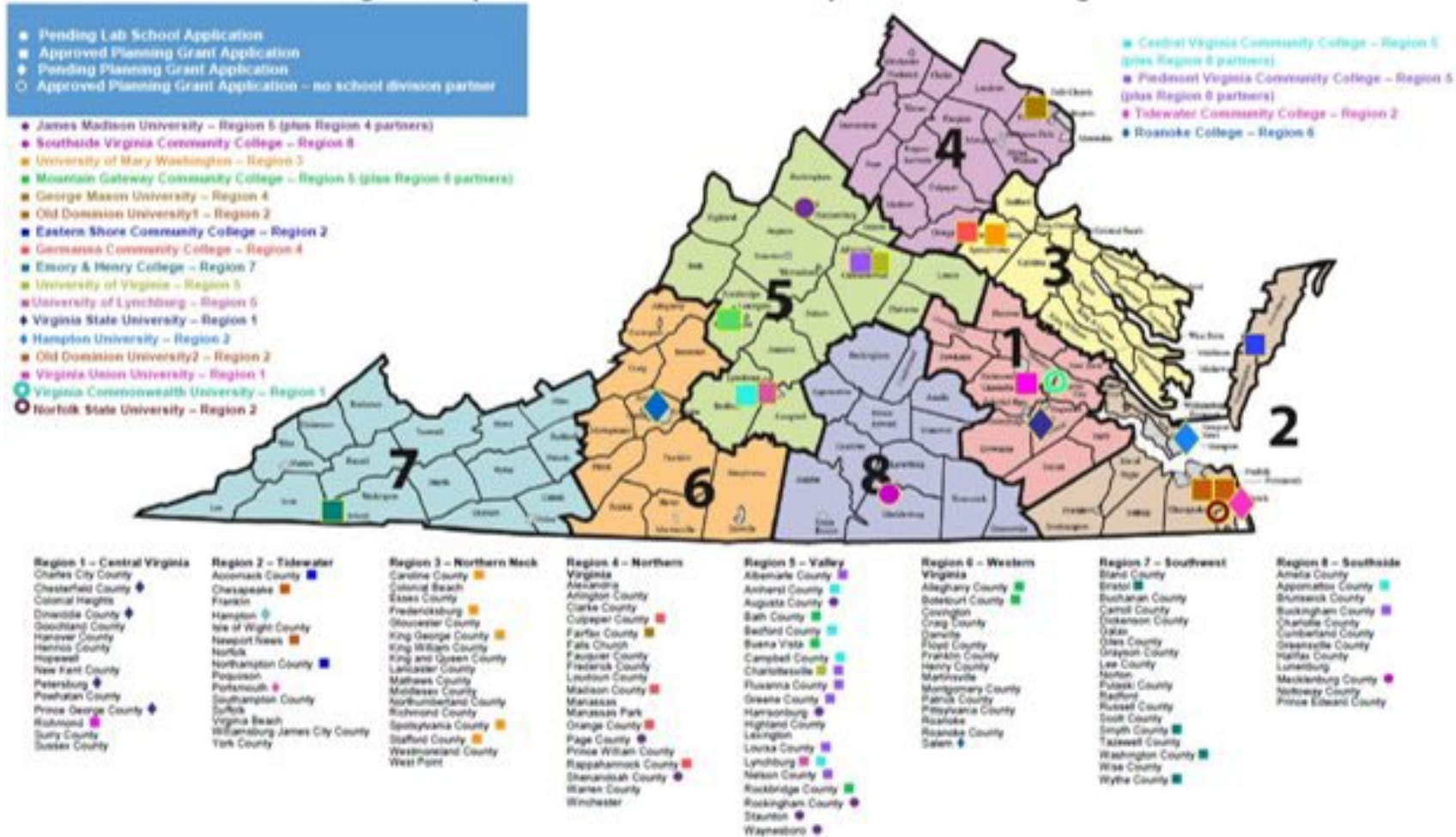

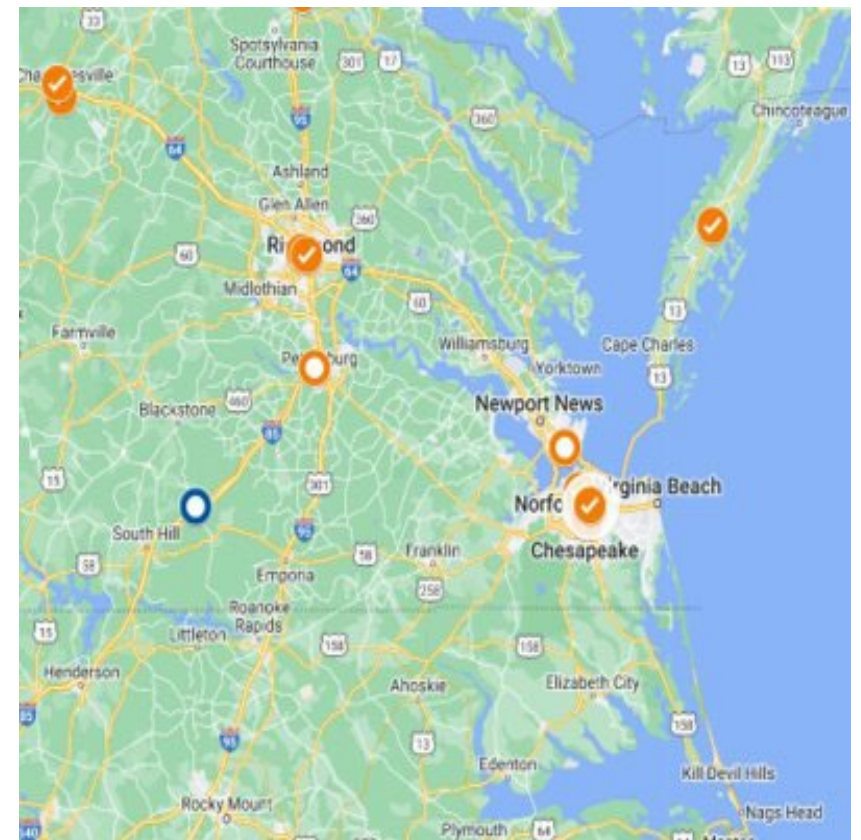

Proposed Focus of Lab School
Reading for STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics) interdisciplinary, gifted program constructed to shape early literacy skills of students in grades PK3 through 2nd. Regular in-service training for teachers in evidence-based literacy instruction to allow effective lesson planning. The teaching of creativity and reading is integrated into all instruction, with learning activities that are engaging and relevant to each of the fields within STEAM.

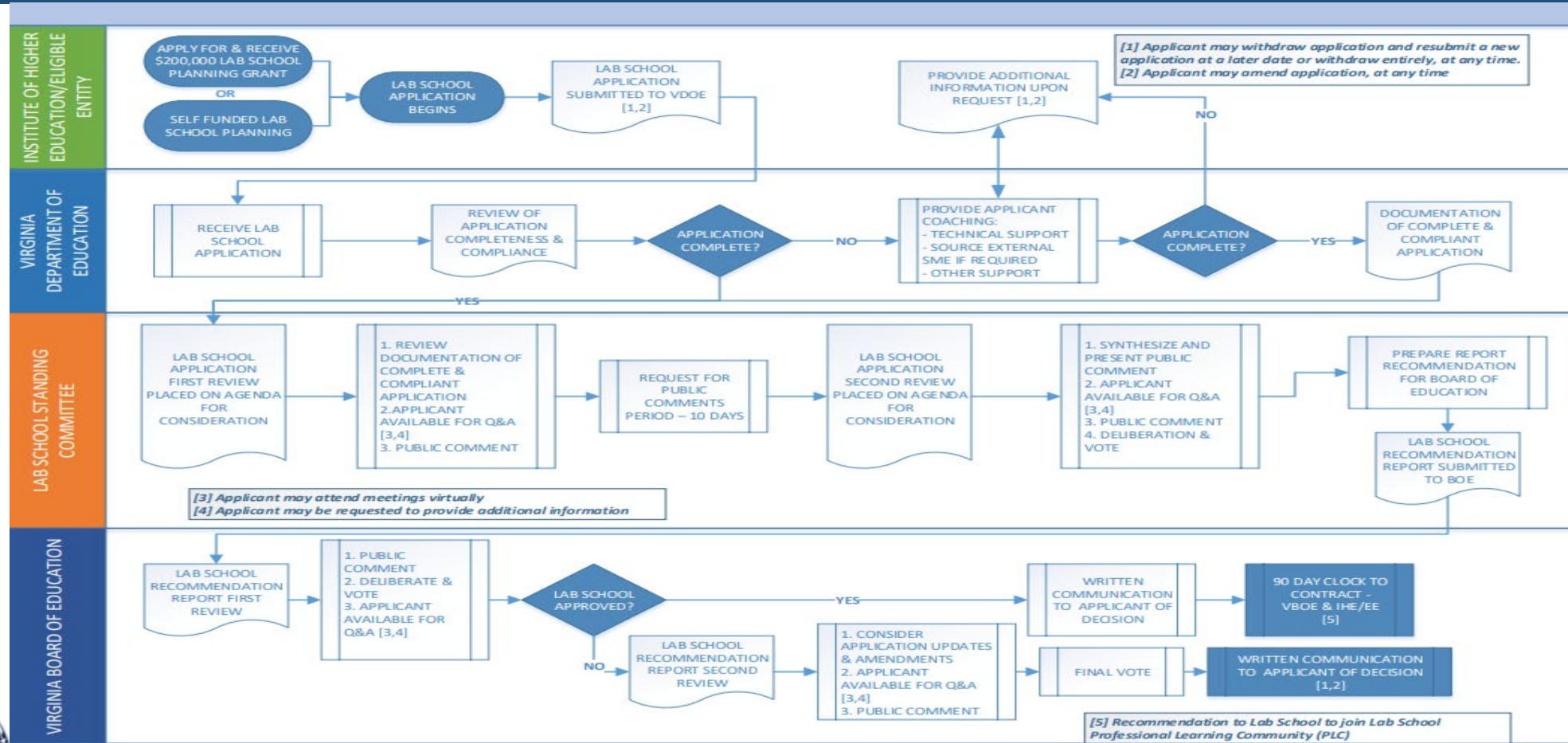
