HB1353	Cohen	Statewide maternal health safety initiative; Commissioner of Health, et al., to evaluate, report.
HB815	Downey	Virginia Health Workforce Development Authority; administration of nursing scholarships.
HB1284	Downey	State plan for medical assistance; provider-to-provider consultation.
HB66	Feggans	Federal benefit programs; DMS & DSS shall study technology systems used to administer.
HB1398	Franklin, M.A.	Fetal and Infant Mortality Review Team; established, definitions, penalty, report.
